(1) Describe why do business processes need flexibility.

(2) The Authority for Number Portability of Cellular Phones (ANPCP) is a National Agency managing the portability of phone numbers among the several operators of the national market. When a customer decides to change his/her mobile phone operator, he/she goes to ANPCP, fills in a form with his/her data, including the phone number to be ported and the selected new operator, a clerk inserts the data in the system: hence, the process starts and the customer will then be kept informed via SMS.

ANPCP checks in the National Phone Directory (which is consulted for every phone call to determine the operator managing every mobile phone number) if the phone number is black-listed, and, if so, the customer is informed and the process ends. Otherwise, ANPCP contacts the selected mobile phone operator and waits for the acceptance. If the operator refuses the customer (e.g. for previous invoices still unpaid), ANPCP informs the customer via a SMS, and the customer has to specify another mobile phone operator for the current request, or to withdraw the request.

If the mobile phone operator accepts the customer, ANPCP informs the the customer's previous operator about the change, updates the National Phone Directory, confirms the request with the new mobile phone operator, and informs the customer.

Every communication between ANPCP and the mobile phone operators is performed by inserting tuples in a database table managed by a shared DBMW.

Provide a reasonable schema of the outlined process(es), according to the modeling formalisms of WIDE. Please, suitably model all the *pre-conditions* and *post-conditions* of every task.

(3) With respect to the process described in Exercise 2, provide an example of a supertask and the related local transaction (with subtransactions) managing the cancelation of the phone number from the past operator to the new operator.
