(2) The TaBiblia library is going to develop a support system for its business. TaBiblia loans books and magazines to borrowers, who are previously registered in the system.

Borrowers can make on-line reservations and check-out their currently borrowed items. The maximal duration of a loan is 30 days for books and 10 days for magazines: loan renewals are allowed only if the loan duration has not expired yet.

When the requested book is not available, the borrower can make a reservation, eventually joining the queue of requesters for that book: TaBiblia will send him/her a message when the book is available again. In this case the system will guarantee that the current borrower of the reserved book or magazine does not renew it. The librarian of TaBiblia checks conditions of books and magazines from time to time (i.e., when the book or the magazine is checked-out), in order to preserve their good quality: if they do not respect the minimal criteria of quality any longer, they are removed from the shelves.

Provide a reasonable schema of the outlined process(es), according to the modeling formalisms of WIDE. Please, suitably model all the *pre-conditions* and *post-conditions* of every task.

(3) With respect to the process described in Exercise 2, provide an example of an exception that, in case of a late check-out, temporarily suspends that borrower from the loan.
