**(2)** The Ele oil company wants to start a special discount campaign for its registered customers, enabling them to receive a 2% discount on night fuels (from 8:00 pm. to 6:00 a.m.) and a 4% discount on Sunday fuels (all day long). Discounts are not cumulative.

Ele sends out e-mail messages to the managers of every fuel station, requesting their interest in participating to the campaign. As soon an agreement is received from one station, Ele sends out to that fuel station the required advertising material.

Whenever a customer shows up at any fuel station, the *ATM* reads the customer's fidelity card, makes all the required checks (e.g., the station participates to the campaign, the customer is a registered one), and decides which kind of discount applies. At the end of the fuel procedure, the bill is issued, the payment is received, and all the data about the customer (Id, paid amount, gasoline amount, discount, fuel station) are stored.

Assume to have two external database tables, namely *Station* and *Customer*, providing all the needed information about fuel stations and customers, respectively.

Provide a reasonable schema of the outlined process(es), according to the modeling formalisms of *WIDE*. Please, suitably model all the *pre-conditions* and *post-conditions* of every task.

**(3)** With respect to the process described in Exercise 2, provide an example of a reasonable exception that disables the customer from receiving future discounts if the amount of the currently purchased gasoline exceeds 100 liters.
